The Epidemiological Observatory Service of the Prevention Department is entrusted with the task of monitoring the state of health, risk and health-promoting factors and their distribution in the population at a provincial level. The Epidemiological Observatory Service supports the department's management and the community in setting priorities, making decisions, planning and implementing strategies that enable everyone to achieve or maintain the highest possible standard of health. It works in close liaison with the other services and units of the Prevention Department, requesting advice on the interpretation of data and, conversely, making its epidemiological-statistical skills available to address specific problems of individual services and units.

Specifically, the Epidemiological Observatory Service coordinates the PASSI surveillance system (Passi and Passi d'Argento) on a provincial level and participates in the National Technical Group at the Istituto Superiore di Sanità (ISS); collaborates in the coordination of the Zero-Due, Okkio and HBSC systems on a provincial level; coordinates the planning and monitors the Provincial Prevention Plan; produces fact sheets on various prevention and health promotion topics; prepares reports on the health of particular population groups (the elderly, workers, immigrants) or on other relevant topics (SDGs, gender and health) it provides lectures at seminars, conferences and training courses using in an integrated manner the data of the various surveys, other routinely collected data on health related issues, articles from the biomedical literature and other scientific sources; it collaborates, in liaison with the ASUIT Communications Office and together with the other services of the Prevention Department, in the dissemination of health information using the various communication media available to the ASUIT.

Given my family background and personal history I have always lived and worked in a multicultural environment without any problems. During my professional activity I have been able to develop communication skills in many areas: reports to political and administrative decision-makers at a national (ministry representatives, ISS) and provincial level (councillors, permanent commissions of the provincial council, council of local autonomies); scientific communications (reports at conferences, scientific articles); communications and interviews via radio, television and social media; teaching activities; assemblies and meetings with citizens concerned about various health aspects (infectious diseases, cancer, environmental pollution) or interested in learning more about health promotion issues (disease prevention, healthy lifestyles, social determinants of health). In the context of the participatory construction of the Trentino health plan, I came into contact with various players, associations and key figures, and liaised with central and local government bodies in the health and social policies sectors and with the civil society.

Teamwork has always been essential in all activities and has allowed me, over the years, to establish a solid professional network from which I can draw as a valuable resource for discussions, suggestions and problem solving.

In 2012 I was entrusted with the task of building ex novo the health observatory of the province of Trento. The observatory was active until 2020 and was a well recognised organisation at provincial level, with connections also at national and international level. During my professional career I have coordinated a number of working groups, and I am/was coordinator of various projects (provincial prevention plans, health plan, etc). I have been the editor-in-chief of the newsletter of the Italian network of vaccination services (niv), coordinating the editorial work with weekly editions of the newsletter for 8 years (voluntary work). At a national level I am a member, since its origin in 2007, of the technical group coordinated by the ISS, which coordinates the Passi (and subsequently Passi d'argento) surveillance systems on health-related behaviour in Italy, for which I also coordinate the activities of data collection, archiving and analysis, the dissemination of results and the ongoing training of interviewers in Trentino. In 2020 I was an part of the COVID-19 emergency team for Italy of the WHO. I am member of the Italian association of epidemiology (AIE) where I coordinate the Working group on peace promotion. In 2024/2025 I was a guest associate editor of the scientific journal Frontiers in Public Health.
