INSTRUCTIONS FOR URINE CYTOLOGY TESTS

Collect a urine sample once a day on three consecutive mornings, as follows:

- 1. As soon as you get up, urinate normally into the toilet.
- 2. Drink at least two glasses of water (you may have breakfast as usual).
- 3. Once you have washed with normal running water (do not use soap), collect your second urine of the morning using the container with the white lid.
- 4. Allow the specimen to stand for approximately half an hour.
- 5. Without stirring, carefully pour away the top part of the urine and keep about 30 mL (using the graduated scale on the container with the white lid).
- 6. Poor the 30 mL of urine into the large test tube with a blue lid containing the preservative solution.
- 7. Write your surname, name, date of birth and specimen number (1, 2 or 3) on the test-tube with the blue lid.
- 8. Store at room temperature.
- 9. Repeat the procedure for the second and third specimen collection days using the second and third blue test-tube, respectively.
- 10. Once the collection is completed, deliver all the three samples using the methods established for the delivery of materials to the APSS Specimen Collection Centers
- 11. Delivery is scheduled from Monday to Friday; in case of completion of the collection on Saturdays, Sundays and holidays, delivery can be made on the first subsequently available working day
- 12. In case of problems, samples can be stored at room temperature for up to seven days.

N.B.:

- Upon indication of the proscribing doctor it is possible to collect only one or two samples.
- The containers for collection are available from all Sample Collection Centres.
- Take your GP referral form with the instructions and the necessary clinical information.
- If you are eligible for exemption from subsidised medical charges, this must be indicated on the GP referral form.
